

Notice & Invitation East Helena Smelter Public Meeting & Open House

Offices of the Montana Environmental Trust Group (METG) 325 Manlove Avenue, East Helena, MT 59635 November 14, 2012, 6:30 to 8:30 pm

The US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Montana Environmental Trust Group, Trustee of the Montana Environmental Custodial Trust, are sponsoring a Public Meeting and Open House on November 14th. Representatives from EPA and the Trust will review the <u>Draft 2013 Interim Measures Work Plan</u>, which describes cleanup plans to be implemented at the former Asarco Smelter next year. The meeting will provide the public with an important opportunity to learn about and comment on the <u>Draft 2013 Interim Measures Work Plan</u>. The open house will feature informational exhibits about groundwater cleanup efforts, redevelopment studies and other topics of interest to the community.

Directions to METG Offices:

Manlove Avenue is near the former Asarco Smelter. It is south of Highway 12 and parallels the Highway and the railroad tracks. Manlove Avenue intersects Highway 282 and is across from American Chemet.

- <u>From Helena</u>, take Highway 12 east. Make a right onto Highway 282 (at the traffic light). Make a right onto Manlove Avenue, which is the first street on the right.
- <u>From Townsend</u>, take Highway 12 west. Make a left onto Highway 282 (at the traffic light). Make a right onto Manlove Avenue, which is the first street on the right.
- <u>From Montana City</u>, take Highway 282 north past the Asarco Smelter on the right and the Rodeo Grounds on the left. Make a left onto Manlove Avenue, which is the last street before Highway 12.

Look for the green modular building with the METG logo on the left!
